

Proper Use, Storage, and Warranty of Rogers® Splitter™ Turf Base

Rogers® Splitter™ Turf Base is designed specifically for synthetic turf fields with a minimum depth of 1 inch. Rigid rubber spikes molded to the underneath side combined with additional interior weight hold the base firmly in place. The base top has anti-skid, white rubber material, UV inhibitors to prevent yellowing, and ribbed corners for better base rounding.

Installation is as simple as lining up the base at the proper location and then slowly working the spikes into the turf. The Splitter™ Turf Base is durable and designed for all levels of play.

1. Placement on the Field:

 Set bases at the correct distance and slowly work the spikes of the base into the turf.

2. Usage Guidelines:

 The bases will stay in place during normal base running, rounding, and proper sliding. Late or improper slides may cause the base to move and reduce the possibility of injury. If the base moves, find the correct location and slowly work the spikes of the base into the turf.

3. Storage Recommendations:

- Store bases in a dry location when not in use to prevent weather damage.
- Do NOT stack bases or allow weight to push down on the spikes of the base as this may cause the spikes to bend and hinder future performance. Turn the bases on their side when storing.
- Avoid storing bases where they could be crushed or subjected to extreme temperatures.

4. Two-Year Limited Warranty:

Rogers Base Company, LLC ("Rogers") warrants to the original purchaser that each set of bases covered under this warranty is free from defects in material and workmanship for two years from the date of purchase. Rogers® will repair or replace products that have failed within the two-year warranty period.

Following these guidelines will help extend the lifespan of the Rogers® Splitter™ Baseball Bases and ensure safe and consistent play on the field.
